## Camp coaches

Mizzou Head Coach **Kyle Hawkins** is the camp director. Several years of working as a director in Nike Lacrosse Camps and coaching high school and collegiate lacrosse have made him one of the most sought-after camp coaches in the country.

Coach **Eddie Hedrick** works specifically with goalies. Coach Hedrick played varsity lacrosse at Bowling Green University (Ohio) and in 1967 was named All-American Goaltender. Coach Hedrick's extensive knowledge is highly valued nationwide.

**Joel Henning** is head coach at Olathe East High School in Olathe, Ks., a 2003 MU graduate and former multi-year All-American defenseman for the Tigers.

**Jason Seidel**, former MU midfielder and later assistant coach on national championship teams at Colorado State University; also former assistant coach at MU.

**Jamie Mullen** is head coach at Hickman High School in Columbia, Mo., a 2001 MU graduate, and former MU Lacrosse multi-year All-American midfielder.

Other camp staff and MU players will work on the fundamentals of lacrosse in individual, group and game situation drills. Each evening will be capped off with full field games.

**Additional camp staff**, including current MU players, will teach lacrosse fundamentals in individual, group and game situation drills. Each evening is capped with full field games.

## Accommodations

Overnight campers will stay in a campus dormitory. It is air-conditioned and close to the lacrosse fields.

Overnight campers will have three meals a day provided in the cafeteria, and will need to bring pillows and bed linens. Campers will be supervised at all times by camp staff. Specific roommates may be requested. Day campers will have daily lacrosse instruction with the Overnight campers, but will not receive breakfast or be allowed to stay on campus past 9 p.m.

A complete packing list and directions to camp will be provided by e-mail approximately two weeks prior to camp.
